

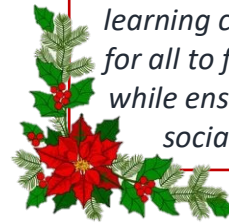

Put a smile on a child's face by donating a new toy for a child who will have to spend the holidays at Children's Hospital.

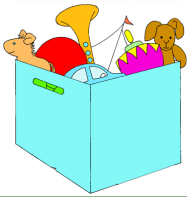
Bring a new toy/item to school between **December 3rd-14th**
